### I. Call to Order

#### **II.** Introduction of Guests

## **III. Previous Meeting Minutes**

B. Hoffman submitted the minutes from the February 8, 2011 meeting for review. No additions or corrections were made. J. McNally moved to approve the minutes as corrected; seconded by R. Riddle. Motion carried 6-0.

## IV. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>

M. Donahue presented the Treasurer's Report orally. Motion made to approve the report as presented and seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

## V. 2011 Grant Applications

Report was given regarding grant applications. We have received 9 applications for a total of \$18,000. We can cover all of the applications if we hit revenue projections. It was agreed to stick to the \$12,000 budget but seek more money. B. Hoffman met with Dawn Zandt District Director of Curriculum and Instruction. We will apply to major contributors for funds, e.g. for 3-year author in residence; contact Grafton Rotary. R. Kranitz will meet with investment committee re endowment and share report of current returns experienced with investments another fund is achieving.

### VI. Seeds to Harvest

- A. Planning for this year's event Planning committee to meet on (maybe) April 26<sup>th</sup> @ 7:00. Abby Schroeder is the chairperson.
- B. Event sponsorship The Chamber of Commerce has sponsors for major events at \$5,000 each. We should seek sponsors for major events. We need to define what sponsor gets and to review expenses. We could possibly rent better space with a sponsorship. B. Hoffman will draft a letter. After more discussion, a motion was made to approve \$500 to make sign for the endowment campaign. Motion carried 6-0.

## VII. Major Giving -

- A. <u>PR Campaign</u> Normally, it takes 3 years to get a major gift. We have a list of 70 potential givers. We will do annual fundraisers one at the beginning of the school year and one at the end.
- B. <u>Identification of Major Givers</u> We have found other non-profits by zip code with links to Form 990 (e.g., Exacto Spring and founder (Heitz) which has \$3M in funds).
- C. <u>Update to Major Givers</u> We reviewed the list of the donors who contributed to our Foundation.
- D. <u>Fund-raising and Development Conference</u> There is a seminar scheduled on fund raising June 1-3. B. Hoffman would like to attend at a cost of \$425.
- E. <u>Identifying funding opportunities for Major Givers</u> We are making a list of fundraising ideas. Lists should be given to Abby Schroeder for review.
- F. <u>Portraits in the Park</u> This event is scheduled for September 11<sup>th</sup>. Motion to include this event as a fundraiser was made by J. McNally and seconded by R. Riddle. Motion carried 6-0.

**VIII.** <u>Additional Committee Reports</u> – We will need three leaders for the Packer game fundraisers. One for each game. There will be a planning session on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

#### IX. Strategic Planning -

- A. <u>Coordination with Grafton School District</u> Dr. Pechura believes that the role of GEF and similar organizations will increase as a result of State budget cuts, since school revenues will be cut and work rules will change. - B. <u>This month's exercise</u> 24-hour math curriculum by computer. Develop public/private Partnership.
- X. <u>Other Matters</u> We discussed white paper from CESA. Grafton is a pioneer in CESA One. According to Arnie Duncan, Secretary of Education, most local people don't know about program yet.
