I. Call to Order

II. <u>Previous Meeting Minutes</u>

B. Hoffman submitted the minutes from the April 28, 2010 Executive Committee meeting for review. No additions or changes were made. R. Kranitz moved to approve the minutes as presented; seconded by K. Walton. Motion carried 5-0.

III. Treasurer's Report

M. Donahue presented the Treasurer's Report for review. No additions or changes were made. R. Kranitz moved to approve the report as presented; seconded by S. Vepraskas. Motion carried 5-0.

IV. Committee Reports -

A. <u>Publicity/Website Committee</u> – R. Riddle presented photos for review. We have the rights to use these photos. We have a Facebook page now. The committee is working on the website. The committee is also in the process of

- developing FAQs for the website. The site will enable online donations.
- B. <u>Grant Committee</u> The committee (A. Shanks, C. Bauer and K. Walton) will meet in June.
- C. <u>Executive Committee</u> The committee met April 28th (see minutes). It recommended Committee Charters and are currently working on Working Policies.
- D. <u>Governance and Nominating Committee</u> Has not met yet.
- E. <u>Fund Raising Committee</u> S. Davis will continue.

V. <u>Old Business</u>

- A. <u>Identification of Potential Pioneer Contributors</u> We need to meet with Port Washington State Bank.
- B. <u>Silent Auction Update</u> The Silent Auction will be held October 23, 2010 at The Family Farm. So far there is a 4-person committee.
- C. <u>Develop Theme for 2010 Silent Auction</u> We discussed many theme possibilities and have settled on "Seeds to Harvest".

VI. New Business

- A. Should the GEF Join the Grafton Area Chamber of Commerce We discussed the pros of joining the Chamber; such as, a directory listing, web listing, access to mailing let, no regular meetings. M. Donahue moved that the Foundation join the Chamber; seconded by R. Riddle. Motion carried 7-0. The Chamber will announce GEF as a "new member" on May 20th.

- C. <u>Executive Committee Recommendation of Board</u>
 <u>Membership</u> The Executive Committee recommends a

non-voting teacher liaison. This person would not be subject to our attendance policy, but their input would be helpful. "Non-voting" status would remove any pressure on them. This person would be called our "Staff Liaison". S. Davis moved to appoint April Shanks as the "Staff Liaison"; seconded by K. Walton. Motion carried 6-0.

- D. Scherzer has tendered a resignation as a board member. K. Walton moved to accept his resignation; seconded by R. Kranitz. Motion carried 6-0. We have recommended that Dave be listed as a "Foundation Member".
- D. <u>Election of Officers for 2010 2011</u> A Recommendation was made for the current officers to continue through the next year. We discussed the need to begin recruiting new board members now, on a face-to-face basis. We will not ask for volunteers.

We have made a "soft launch" announcement in the <u>Chalkboard</u>. In June, we will follow-up with a "hard launch" to give information on what we are; our first-year timeline; our fall fundraiser, plans to make grants in May and the website in June.
