#### I. Call to Order

Bob Hoffman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. This is a regular meeting of the Board of Directors.

#### II. <u>Previous Meeting Minutes</u>

Bob Hoffman submitted the minutes from the September 10, 2013 meeting for review. M. Cibulka made a motion that K. Walton seconded to approve the minutes. The motion carried 6-0.

## III. Portraits in the Park – Julia McNally

Julia reported that there were 24 sittings, compared to 29 sittings last year. The scheduled date was rained out, but the sittings all were rescheduled. All of the numbers are not final, but the revenue is approximately \$720.

Bob requested a list of parent addresses from Dr. Lightner. He felt a letter to parents would be an effective way to ask for donations to the annual Seeds to Harvest giving campaign. Mike reported that the balance of the checking account is very low, but that funds are available in other accounts.

He has picked up the GEF Green Apple mascot costume that was ordered from Darcey Devens. However, several of the PCV connections are loose, so additional work is needed on the costume. He has tried unsuccessfully several times to contact her.

Finally, he suggested that the Foundation should upgrade its Google Drive EXCEL based file of contacts to a Data Base such as Microsoft ACCESS. It was suggested that Bob should also look into using Constant Contact as a possible solution.
